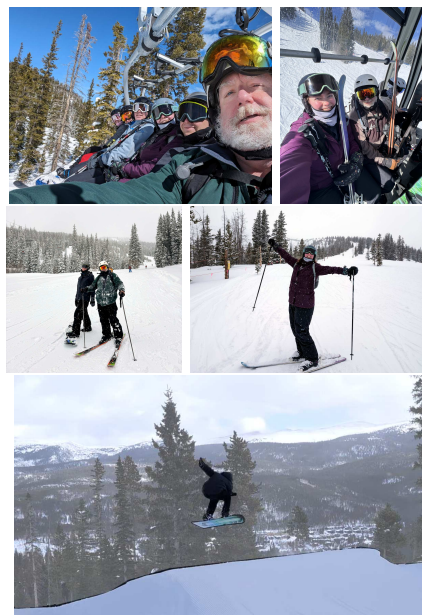
MIA'S PLEIADES

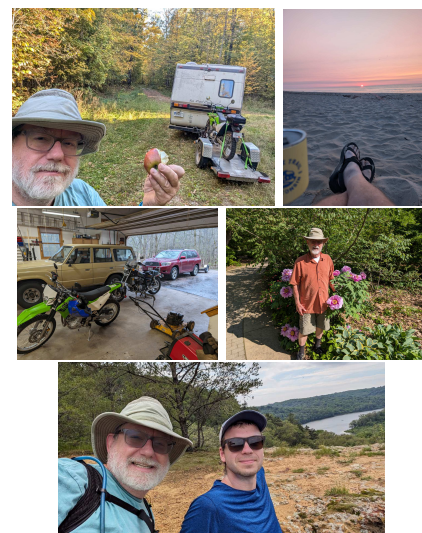
ON THE WATER!

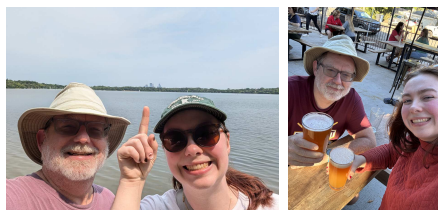
GOOD EATING

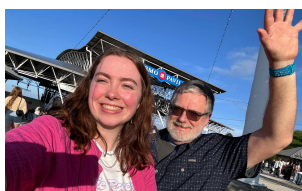
WORK, LIFE, BALANCE

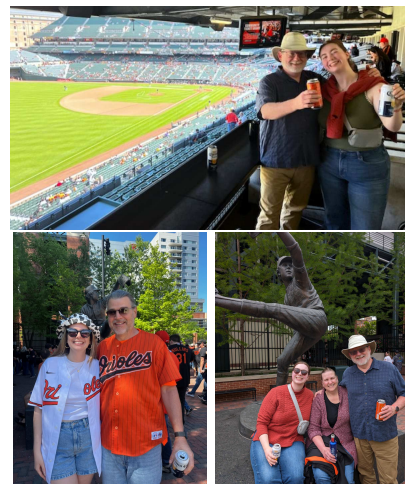
